






DEMOGRAPHIC RESULTS

40–49 years: 30.9%


50-60 years: 55%




Figure 2. Copyright information resources consulted by respondents



RESULTS COPYRIGHT POLICIES AND INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL






Figure 3. Copyright policies at institutional level



RESULTS PREFERRED FORMS FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION






Figure 4. Preferred forms for continuing education
