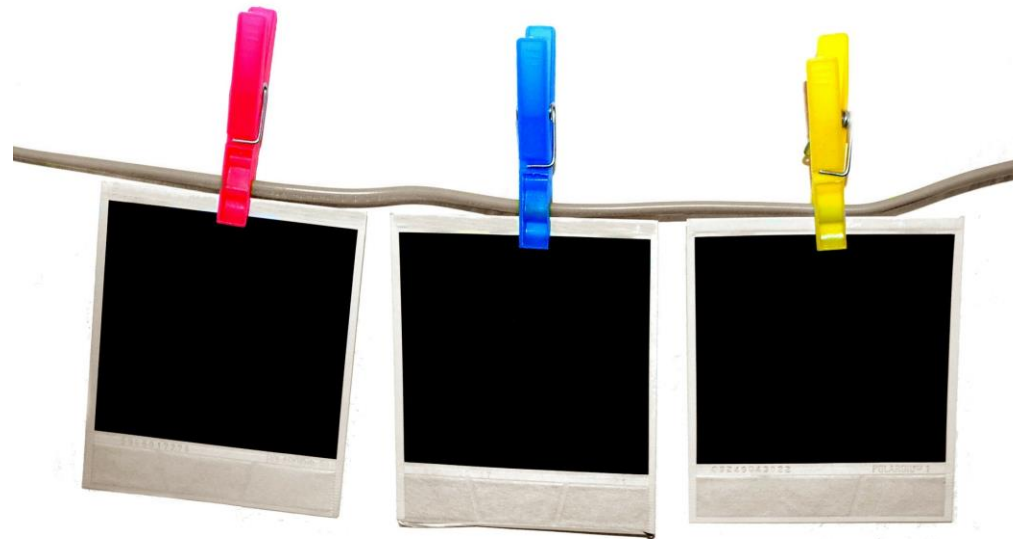

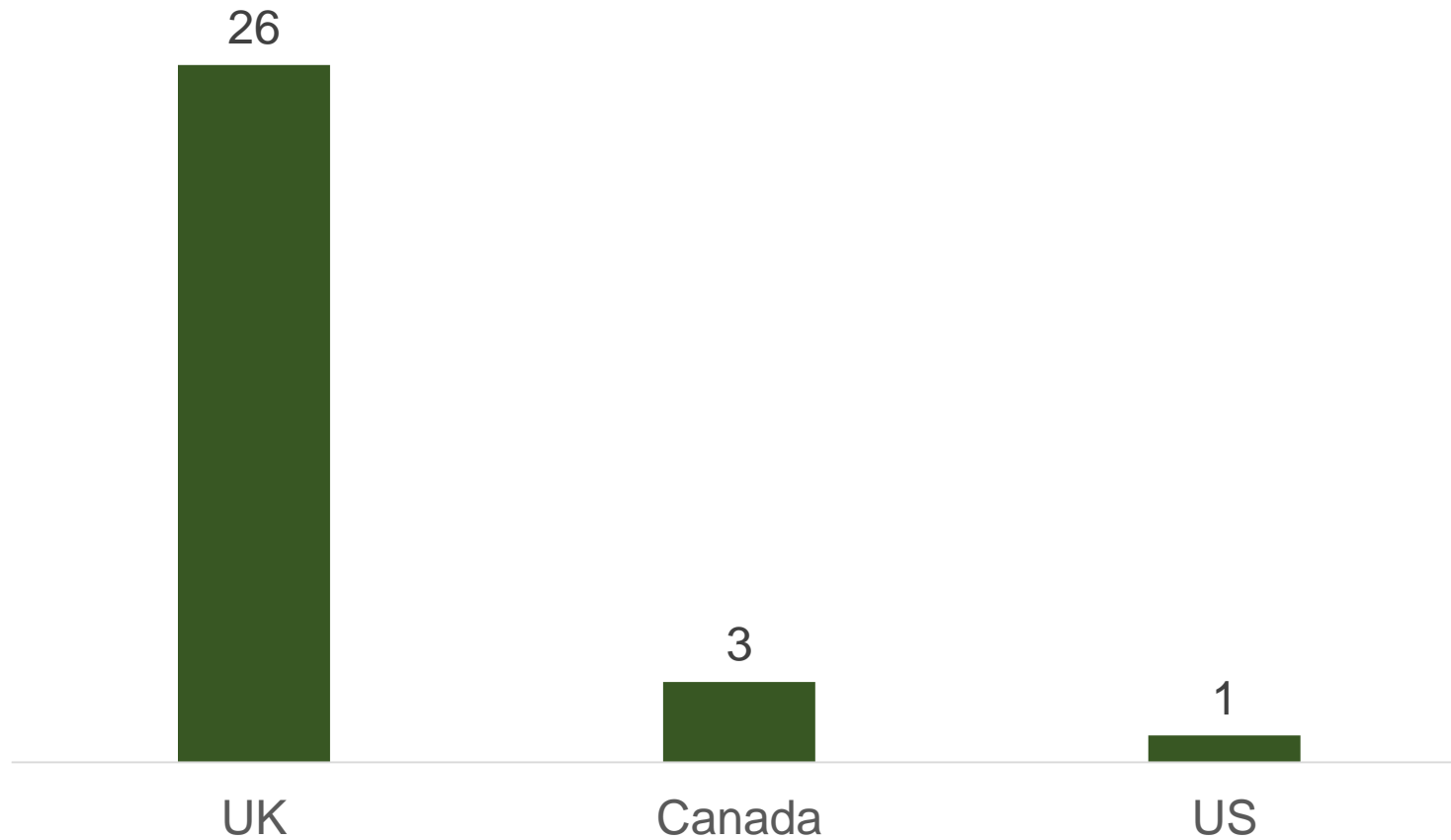

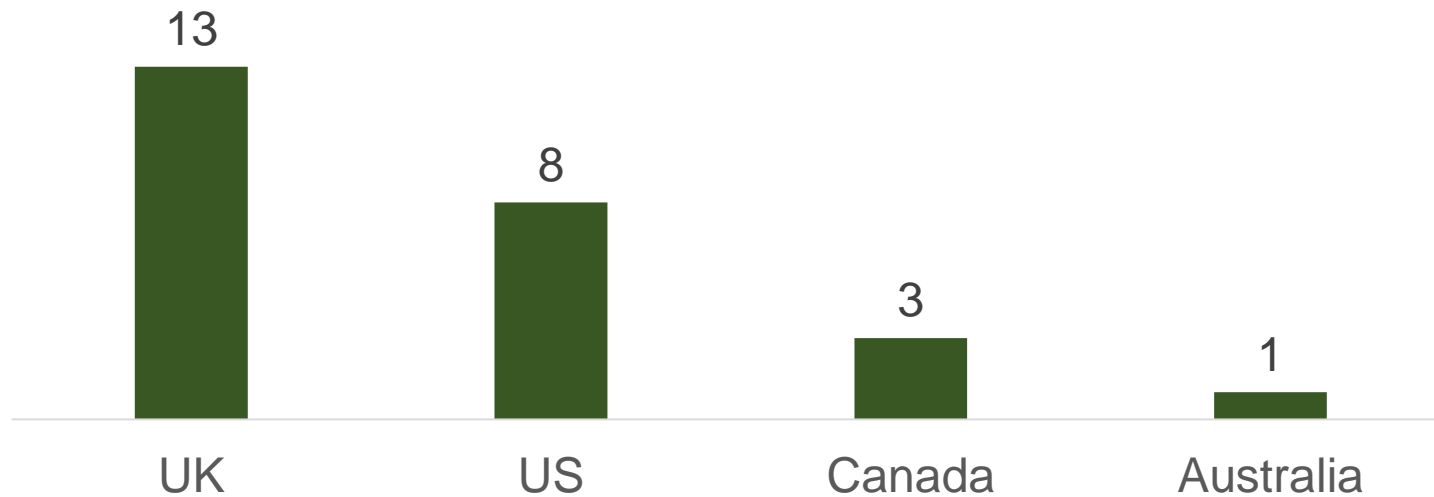


Authors' countries of affiliation: 2006



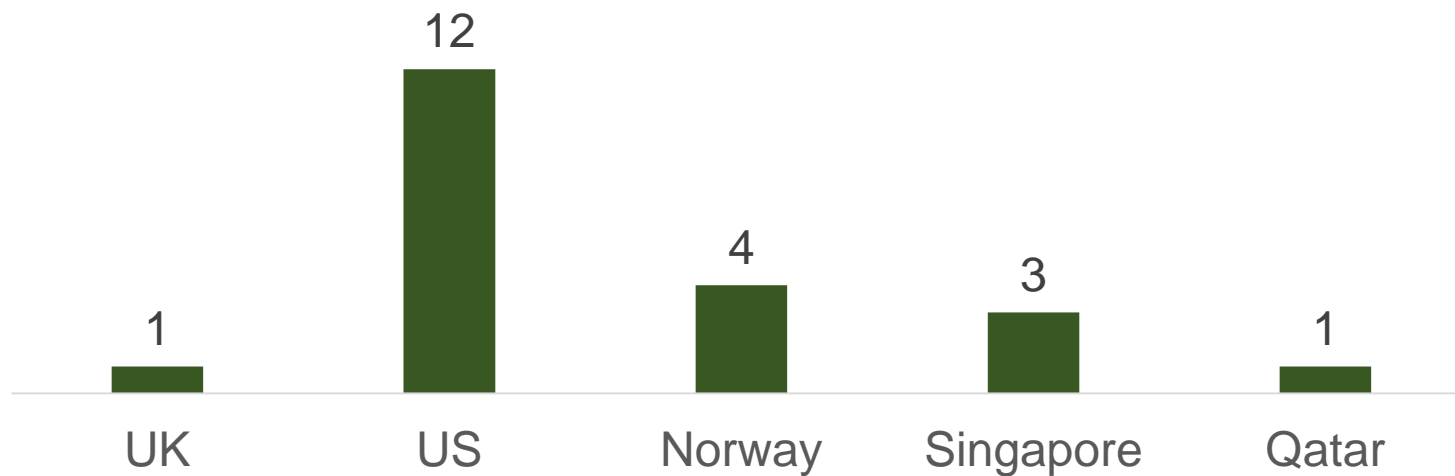

Authors' countries of affiliation: 2011-12



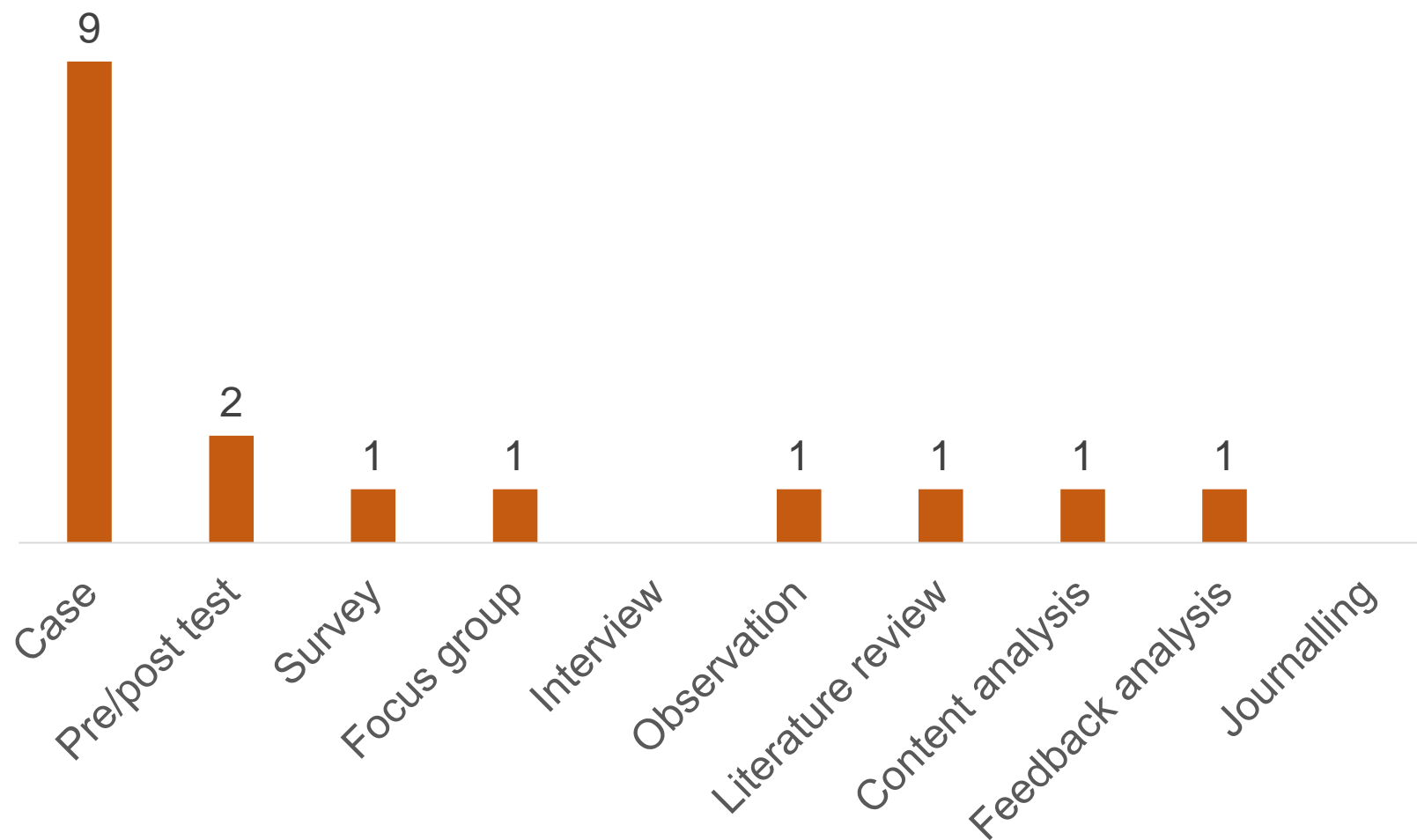

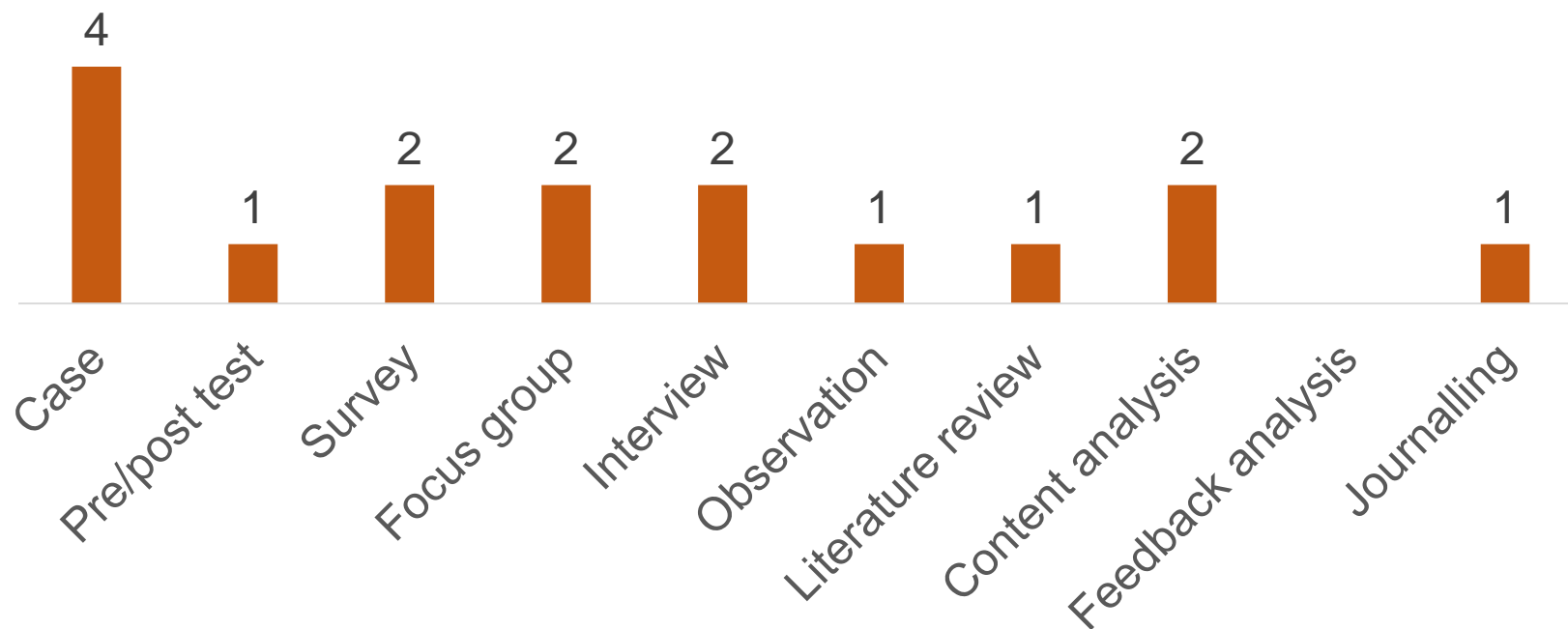
